Mrs. Murphy's ~ 3rd & 4th Grade Classroom ~ The third and fourth grade will be playing the bells before both church services this Sunday in addition to singing in both services. They need to be in Mrs. Wilson's room no later than 8:10.

The fourth grade spent the week making Chinese dragons, and the third grade made masks. Both are on display at our room entrance.

We have been studying the properties of sound this week. Today we explored how various sounds are made from boom whackers to space phones.

Next week Friday is a half day of school for the students.

We had a fantastic week filled with learning. In math, 2nd graders worked with 3 digit ordering, time in 5-minute increments and adding 3 digits over 100. 1st graders began adding 2 digit numbers, continued working with doubles +1, identified more on a graph and learned about congruent shapes. WOW!

1st graders learned the 6 rules for capitalization in English, while 2nd graders are starting to take apart sentences and analyzing them even further.

I am also checking personal information knowledge. If your child does not know their address or phone number, you will receive a note in their clear folder. Please send it back with your child when they can recite it.

Mrs. Olson's ~ Kindergarten ~ Kindergarten had no school today because I was hosting the 31st annual In-Service Day for kindergarten teachers. There was a good exchange of information and ideas.

This week on Monday State Representative John Walsh came to school and read a story to grades K-4 for March Reading Month.

This week we are working on Letterbook P. We also learned about two syllable words. It is easy to figure them out when we split them into the two parts.

In math we are identifying numbers 1-20 and putting them in order. We also weighed objects using a balance. We identified full, half full and empty containers and saw how combining containers of different colors could give us a new color. We have also begun a little bit of addition using dice. It was fun using trapezoids, parallelograms and triangles to make the same shape.
